

GENERAL BATTERY CARE

1. Keep the top of the battery clean.
2. Inspect cables and tighten all connections if needed. Replace cables if worn or broken. Clean the interior of the terminals whenever taken off the battery and clean battery posts. To help ward off corrosion, coat all surfaces with vaseline or mineral grease before re-connecting them.
3. Inspect battery cradle and adjust hold-down so that battery is held firmly in place.
4. When adding water to the battery, fill only to level indicator or $3/8$ " above separators.
5. When the battery uses excessive water, this is the result of too much charge (over-charging). In this case the voltage regulator and electrical system should be checked by a competent service man and the voltage regulator set to the particular operating need.
6. If the equipment is not used for a period of 30 days or more, have the battery tested with a hydrometer. If the specific gravity is below 1.225 specific gravity, re-charge the battery.

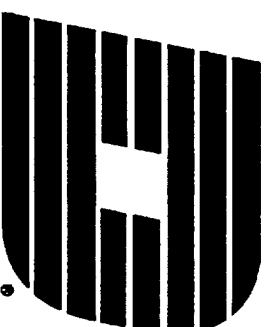

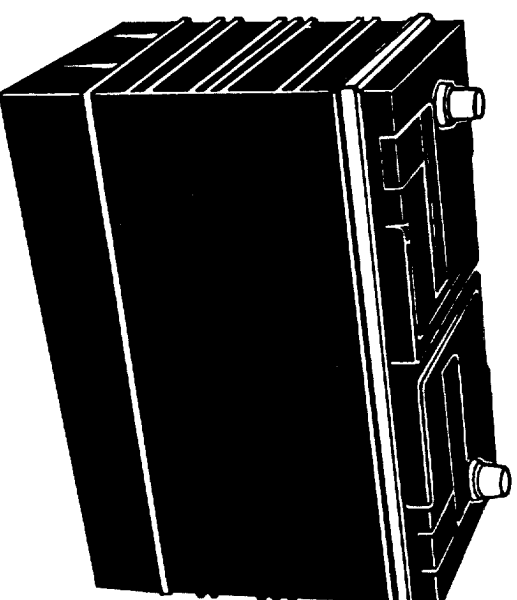

LIMITED WARRANTY**



All Douglas battery distributors are authorized to administer the Douglas Limited Warranty Policy.

The original equipment battery will be replaced with a free equivalent at any Douglas Battery Distributor if it fails due to defective workmanship within 12 months from date of purchase of the vehicle or equipment or within 24 months of the manufacturer's code date (whichever occurs first).

The cost of service calls, battery installation, recharges, or the use of rental batteries is not covered by the warranty. Proof of date of purchase is required for all claims. These warranty and adjustment services are void if the code symbols on the battery are removed or destroyed.

LIMITATIONS

This warranty does not cover:

- Failure in service due to improper installation, wreckage, freezing, explosion, fire, or other accidental damage.
- Cracked cases, covers, terminal post and burnt straps, bulging or distorted cases, resulting from neglect and abuse.
- Failure to have battery inspected and filled with water periodically.
- Addition to the battery of any chemical or solution other than approved water.
- Batteries that are merely run down or discharged.

CONSUMER WARRANTY INFORMATION

If your battery fails, due to defective workmanship, you should contact our main office in Winston-Salem, N. C. at 1-800-368-4527.

Our operator will request your name, address, phone number, name of vehicle or equipment, date of purchase and the date code on the warranty tag.

If the date code is valid, you will be contacted, within minutes, by the nearest Douglas warehouse.

The Douglas warehouse will inform you as to the location of the nearest Douglas dealer.

If you are located outside our distribution area, Douglas Battery will send you a check for the defective battery.

ADJUSTMENTS
